ENTRIES

All tests are open to all breeds eligible for AKC Flushing Spaniels Hunt Tests six months of age or older on the first day of the event.

Entry limited to thirty (30) entries. Entries will close when the limit is reached, if this occurs prior to specified closing time. Preference will be given to Airedale Terriers because these tests are held in conjunction with the National Specialty of the Airedale Terrier Club of America.

Entry Fee: \$55.00 per dog, Junior, Senior or Master, each day. Entries MUST be signed and filled out completely. The appropriate AKC recording fees are included in the entry fee. Checks payable to ATCA must accompany all entries.

Payment may also be made by PayPal remitted to ATCAtreasurer@yahoo.com. PayPal's Unique Transaction ID number must be noted on the entry form.

Entries will close at noon CT, Saturday, September 25th, 2010 with the Hunt Test Secretary, at 1921 West 11th, Irving TX 75060. Running list drawing will take place at 6:00 PM CT Saturday, September 25, 2010 at 1921 West 11th, Irving TX 75060. No telephone entries will be accepted. Signature must be waived on carrier delivered entries. The running order will be emailed to all entrants that include an email address on the entry form.

Only gunners approved by the Hunt Test Committee will be used.

Training, correcting, or disciplining of dogs will not be permitted on the Hunt Test grounds. All dogs must be leashed or confined when not being tested. Please be thoughtful and clean up after yourself and your dogs

Hunt Test Schedule: Junior Senior and Master starting at 8:00 AM Lunch will be at noon or at the judge's discretion.

Birds: Senior and Master: Pheasants and/or Chukars, Juniors: Pheasants and/or Chukars and/or Pigeons

Awards: Standard AKC Rosettes to all dogs receiving Qualifying Scores.

REFUNDS, SCRATCHES, NO SHOWS: Entry fees paid for a bitch withdrawn because of coming into season or for a dog withdrawn because of an injury or illness, or for a dog which dies, shall be refunded in full by the test giving club. Prior to paying such refund, the club may require an appropriate veterinary certificate. Requests and documentation must be presented prior to the test. There will be no refunds for "no shows". Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from the test by action of the Hunt Test Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the Hunt Test Committee.

MOVE-UPS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher Test level (in a second event) if a title is acquired after entries have closed in the second Test, subject to the approval of the Hunting Test Committee of the second event, the availability of birds, payment of the difference, if any, in entry fees, and provided also that the dog is moved up at least one-half hour prior to the start of the second Test. Dogs so moved up will be placed at the end of the drawn running order.
