AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for any event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. Transfer entries will not be accepted at these trials.

ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

Dogs must be kept on leash or crated except when in the judging ring. No flexi or retractable leads in the obedience building.

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under AKC rules are allowed in the obedience building during trial hours.

If case of a tie for any prize, any dog that is not present for a run-off will forfeit its right to the prize. No awards will be mailed.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring on time for judging.

There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the Trial grounds.

Acknowledge of entries should be made soon after the closing date. Should such acknowledgement not be received by an exhibitor five days prior to the Trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

Refund for bitches in season: The club will retain a \$10.00 processing fee. Please note: Refund of entry fees for bitches entered in Rally or Obedience that come in season after closing date of these trials may be obtained by providing a veterinarian's certificate to the show secretary. This certificate must be given to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

No telegraphed, telephoned, faxed, unsigned or incomplete entries will be accepted. **Entries, including fees, must be at the address of the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. Receipt by a commercial entry service is not a substitute for receipt by the Trial Secretary.** Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form or photocopies of forms without an Agreement and Rules with the AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Checks returned by the bank for non-sufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry fee. **Requests for Transfer will be accepted per AKC Regulations.**

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions or any other act or event beyond the control of the California Airedale Terrier Club, Inc., it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refunds of entry fees will be made.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Please type or hand-write neatly on entries. Acknowledgement of acceptance of entry shall occur approximately one week before the date of the trials. Formal confirmation and judging schedule will be sent by U.S. mail. If you do not receive either a pre-trial acknowledgement of receipt or a confirmation, contact the trial secretary immediately.
