1509 Pennsylvania Avenue – within 5 minutes from the host hotel and 10 minutes from the show site

Depending on Covid restrictions at the time, outdoor venue dinner includes a tour of the historic cattle baron era house. Built in 1904, it is a Georgian Revival mansion in the neighborhood once known as Quality Hill, Thistle Hill epitomizes the architectural grandeur of Fort Worth’s wealthy cattle barons. The mansion was listed in the National Register of Historic Places in 1975, designated as a Recorded Texas Historic Landmark in 1977 and designated as Fort Worth’s first Historic and Cultural Landmark in 1978.
